POSITION: **Backup Regional Medical Officer**

SALARY LEVEL: active daily rate 3000dh, on call daily rate 1500dh (*negotiable within a pre-determined range based on selected candidate's verifiable salary history and experience*)

The United States Peace Corps seeks a qualified medical doctor to serve as a backup Regional Medical Officer (RMO), based in Rabat. The backup RMO will provide a temporary coverage, in an active status to the Peace Corps Morocco whenever the RMO is absent or traveling outside Morocco. In addition to this temporary coverage, the Backup RMO must also be available for on call duty as needed.

One or more candidates may be selected from this advertisement, based on need and availability of funding.

DUTIES [A full description of all duties will be listed in the Backup Healthcare Provider's Statement of Work]:

1. Provide medical support to Peace Corps Medical Officers (PCMOs) at sub-regional posts.
2. Provide medical consultative services to Peace Corps Volunteers/Trainees (PCVs/PCTs) and Peace Corps Response Volunteers through the PCMO at sub-regional posts. This includes close oversight of Volunteers following escalation of cases from these posts. Updates provided to OHS regarding escalated cases. Assist as needed with the provision of clinical care to PCVs.
3. Manage Regional Medical Evacuation Site (RMES). Oversee the care of medically- evacuated PCVs with the support of the Regional Health Coordinator (RHC). Act as the primary liaison between the PCV and regional health care providers.
4. Manage logistics for PCVs requiring medical evacuation, either to a RMES, to the United States, or to another location with the support of the RHC. In consultation with the referring PCMO and OHS,

determine or provide accompaniment if indicated. Update referring PCMO and OMS/OHS on significant changes in status of the evacuated Volunteer. Provide written summary on all medically evacuated PCVs including clinical findings and response to treatment.

5. Communicate with sub-regional PCMOs, OHS and the Region regarding relevant health and medical administrative matters.
6. Maintain clinical competency and licensure.

MINIMUM REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Medical Doctor**
- 2. Possess a current license to practice**
- 3. A minimum of eight years clinical experience**
- 4. Experience providing primary care at an international institution or in an overseas environment**
- 5. Professional written and oral proficiency and comprehension in English**

FOR CONSIDERATION - APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING IN THEIR SUBMISSION:

1. A Resume or C.V. - in English - that includes:
 - Professional positions held, identifying duties, responsibilities, dates of employment and reason for leaving
 - Education and training, identifying universities attended, dates of attendance, degrees and diplomas.
 - Professional licenses, certificates, registrations
 - An accounting for periods of unemployment longer than three months
2. Current Medical License
3. A cover letter – in English
4. One letter of reference from a professional colleague that has been written within the last two years
5. All documents must be translated into English

As part of the selection process, initial selected applicants will be scheduled for a personal interview with a Peace Corps Regional Medical Officer(s)
